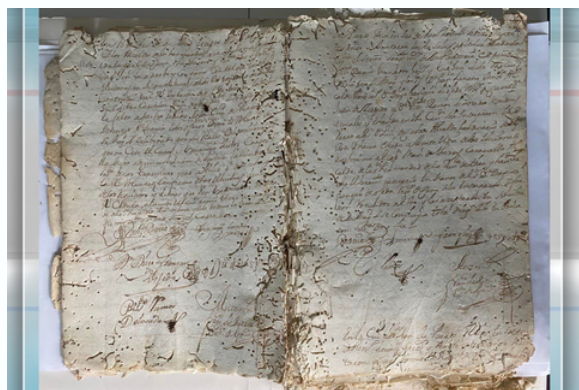
Velada de Tríos

OLDEST DOCUMENT OF COUNCIL OF SAN JUAN

The General Archive of Puerto Rico received a delivery from Professor Lorraine de Castro. While reviewing old family documents, she found an Act of the Cabildo of the city of San Juan dating from January 7, 1722 to July 1, 1730. The oldest known Act was from 1730, which makes this finding in the oldest document of the *Council*"Cabildo" in Puerto Rico.
